

Mary shares her story with TaKen.

Hello, I just wanted to give you a small idea as to what happened to me and my family.

This all began 19 years ago but ended up with my 3 children being taken from me and adopted because my partner (husband now and father of 2 of the children) he was accused of sexually abusing a member of his x wife's family this was vindictive during a custody battle for his 4 children! This was never proven and my husband was branded by social services in all the court documents as a schedule 1 offender(this is incorrect as he had never been charged with anything) this seemed to have a lot of weight in the courts and my 2 children were removed from me and placed into foster care I went on to have 2 abortions due to social services pressure and I secretly had a baby boy who was taken from me at a week old put into foster care and adopted at 18months old my daughters are 21 and 19 now and my son is 15.

I recently had contact with my oldest daughter who did not have a good upbringing in the foster care system and was adopted by a family who have told her contact with me will mean they no longer want contact with her and they have been her family since she was 8.

So she has broken off contact with me again and I am heartbroken once again.

My daughter is very bitter towards me which I understand but she hasn't been told the correct facts she has just been fed a pack of lies.

I have because of this lost my family who disowned me and my mother father 3 siblings and grandparents won't have anything to do with me.

The girls could have gone to live with my husband's parents(father to 2 of the children)but social services would not allow it and my mother wouldn't take the girls because of social services influence

I have been with my husband for 19 years 10 of which we have been married.

But I cannot tell people I have children due to the stigma of losing them we had to move when the children were taken and have been living a secret life ever since with no close friends.

I have tried numerous times to commit suicide due to losing my children, but I now have a grip on living my life.

I just thought I would tell you a brief outline of our story. I always assumed that what happened to us was a rare occurrence and I thank you for what your doing bringing this to the attention of the masses and I hope you can make it so no one ever has to go through this again well done for all your hard work.
